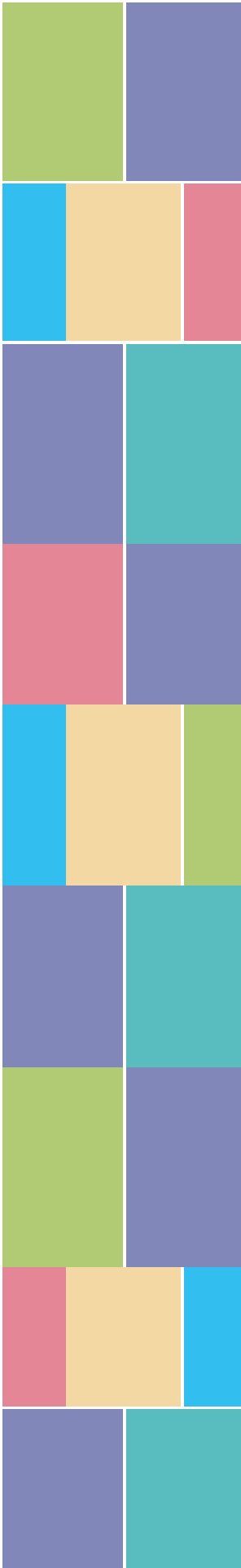


WHERE THE CORNERS MEET QUILT GUILD NEWSLETTER APRIL 2009



The program for this month is The Broken Nine-patch. Please bring at least 2 -nine patches assembled. They can be any size, but we will work with 4 ½” squares which make a 12 ½” block.

Assembly of the block- If you are planning to make a full size quilt, the center block needs to be the same for all of your blocks. This will be the small squares in the quilt. The four corner squares should be the darker color and will not be cut. (could be fussy cut). The remaining four squares should be a lighter fabric. We will have rotary cutters, rulers, and cutting boards for you to use to cut your blocks. We will put blocks together so you can see the overall pattern of the quilt.

Last month we learned a different way to make flying geese. Thank you, Laura Post for a very nice program.

Block lotto is continued to this month. It is spring colors. In July the block lotto is Christmas fabrics.

Shop Owner’s Night is moved to September.

For the picnic, the challenge is any project with a “9” in the name. ex. nine patch purses, table runners, and I’m sure there are more!
