At the July meeting, we will be doing a “Corrugated Quilting Workshop” by Lynda Bortz. The supply list is:

1. A corrugated cardboard piece that will fit a 5” X 7” frame. You can usually buy an inexpensive one at the dollar stores or Wal-Mart.
2. A piece of background fabric approx. $\frac{1}{4}$ ” smaller than the cardboard. This should be a light background that will look nice behind a gingerbread boy.
3. Paper-backed fusible web. Enough for the background piece and pieces you will be putting on top.
4. Paper scissors and fabric scissors.
5. Lynda will provide the pattern, brown fabric, and several small pieces of red for hearts.
6. If you have a black perma-pen with a very fine tip,

Please bring it.
7. We will have irons available and a sewing machine.

In July the block lotto is Christmas fabrics.

We will be trading fabrics to make a Christmas Tree quilt. If you would like to trade, bring:

3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strip X WOF (42”) of red, or red on red fabric
1 strip = 1 block
1 green rectangle for tree that is 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” X 12”

To make a pillow, you only have to make 1 block. To make a wall hanging you will need 4 blocks, and to make a quilt you will need 12 blocks. Any questions, call Lynda Bortz 724-458-7424
