At our October meeting we will make Penny Rug Hearts. You will need to bring:

- 12 to 14" square of felted wool or felt
- scraps of 2 different coordinating colors of felted wool or felt
- Perle cotton or embroidery floss to coordinate
- Pins
- Paper and fabric scissors
- the guild will provide needle and stuffing

This sounds like an interesting and easy project.

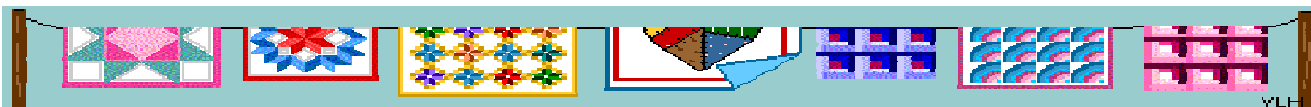

Create at own pace with loving attention while stirring the patterns and placement of the fabrics. Garnish with hand or machine quilting. Serve with loving hugs to recipient or gently coddle for own use. Repeat as often as possible.
