December Program

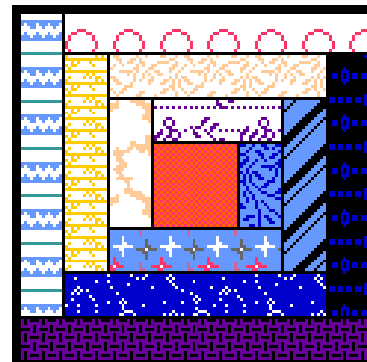
