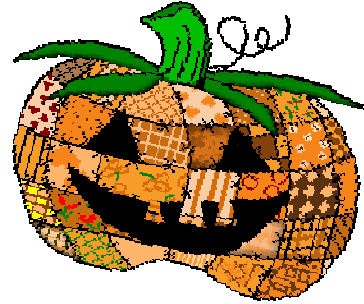


Where The Corners Meet Quilt Guild
