Pineapple Cake

(served at March Guild Meeting)

20# can crushed pineapple—not drained

2 c. flour

2 c. sugar

2 t. baking powder

2 eggs

1 c. crushed walnuts (optional)

1 t. vanilla

Preheat oven to 350

Mix all ingredients and pour into greased 9 X 13" pan. Bake for 35 minutes. (Can also use jelly roll pan and bake for 15 -20 minutes.)

Top with your favorite recipe (or can) of cream cheese icing.

Looking Ahead to June

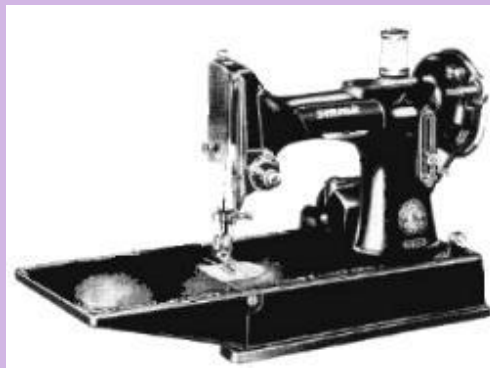
