Drop Filled Cookies

1 c. shortening 2 eggs
2 c. brown sugar 1 t. vanilla
1/2 c. sour milk 1 t. salt
3 1/2 c. flour 1 t. baking soda
1/8 t. cinnamon dash nutmeg

Mix, drop on ungreased cookie sheet. Make indent in center, add filling and put on a top with a little dough. Can use apricot, raisin, date or any filling you desire.

Bake at 350 degrees 10–12 minutes

Cheesecake Pastry

Ingredients

2 tubes crescent rolls 1 t. vanilla
2 8oz. Cream cheese 3/4 c. sugar

1 egg yolk

Glaze

1 egg white 1/3 c. sugar

Cinnamon

Bottom Layer

Lay one tube rolls flat in a 9 X 13 pan.

Middle Layer

Mix together and spread on bottom

3/4 c. sugar 2 8 oz. cream cheese

1 t. vanilla 1 egg yolk

Top

Lay one tube rolls flat on top of filling. Beat glaze ingredients together and drizzle over top. Sprinkle with cinnamon. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes or until done. Serve hot, room temperature or chilled. Refrigerate leftovers.

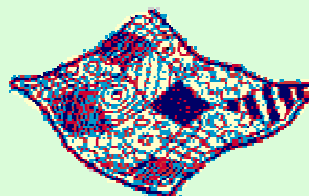
