## *Cheesecake Pastry*

2 tubes crescent rolls  
2 (8 oz.) cream cheese  
3/4 c. sugar  
1 tsp. vanilla  
1 egg

**Bottom Layer:** Lay 1 tube rolls flat in a 9 x 13" pan

**Middle Layer:** Mix 3/4 c. sugar, 2 cream cheeses, 1 tsp. vanilla and egg yolk together. Spread on bottom layer.

**Top Layer:** Lay other tube of rolls on top of filling.

**Glaze:** Beat 1 egg white, 1/3 c. sugar and drizzle over top. Sprinkle with cinnamon.

Bake at 350 for 20 minutes or until done.

Serve hot, room temperature or chilled.

Refrigerate leftovers.
