## ***Apricot Bars***

1 1/2 c. flour

1 t. baking powder

1 c. brown sugar

1 1/2 c. quick rolled oats

3/4 c. melted margarine

1 lb. jar apricot jam

Mix flour, baking powder, brown sugar and oats. Combine with margarine. Pat 2/3 mixture into 9 x 13 pan. Spread on jam to within 1/2" of edge. Cover with rest of crumbs.

Bake at 350 degrees for 35 minutes.
