Membership fee is \$25. You will receive a 15% savings on everything you need for club projects—fabrics, books, patterns, rulers. Our two new clubs are **Ella's Home Place** and **Row Quilt**.

**Ella's Home Place** will meet the third Thursday evening at 7:00 p.m. or the fourth Wednesday morning at 10:00 a.m. each month beginning Sept. 16 & 22. There will be a variety of projects using wool, redwork, and appliqué. I love the book and hope you will too! Book is \$25 (-15%)

**Row Quilt** using a book by Judie Rothermel, we will be sewing a block a month- complete the row at home and bring to each meeting to receive a little something extra. Meetings will be the second Tuesday evening at 7:00 p.m. or the second Thursday morning at 10:00 a.m. beginning Oct. 12 & 14. Book is \$26.95 (-15%).

*Class Schedule: Stop in the shop for more details and to see the samples.*

Beginner's Quilt: *Four sessions on Wednesdays—October 6, 13, 20 & 27 at 7:00 p.m.* A quilt using five different pieced blocks made with only six fat quarters. Learn the basics of cutting and piecing. Class fee \$35; book \$21.95.

Sawtooth Quilt: *Thursday, Oct. 21 from 10:00 a.m. – noon.* A classic pattern constructed with large and small half-square triangles. Yardage is based on fat quarters. Our sample is made with 1840's reproductions by Harriet Hargrave. Class fee is \$10. Pattern is free with purchase of fabric for this class. Kits are available.

BQ: *Wednesday October 15 at 7:00 p.m.* This is possibly the easiest quilt you will ever make! 18" blocks feature an off-center 12" square. No inset seams, no borders to do. Choose just 3 fabrics! Class fee is \$10; pattern \$7.50.

Wool Floral Wallhanging: *Friday, October 22 from 10:00 a.m.—noon.* Come and find out how great it is to work with wool. No edges to turn. You use only two embroidery stitches. Class fee is \$10; pattern is \$8.

Project Tote: *A two session class on Saturdays, October 23 & 30 from 10:00 a.m.—noon.* You choose which Sue Spargo pattern to use, either a 14" x 16" case or 9" x 13". Made with wool and cotton with inserts of vinyl zippered pouches to hold all your project necessities. Class fee is \$15. Pattern for small tote is \$8; pattern for large tote is \$9.50.

Hobo Bag: *Thursday, October 28 from 10:00 a.m.—1:00 p.m.* A very cute bag dressed up with a flower you make! All done in wool. You have a choice of two sizes. Class fee is \$10; pattern is \$8.

Wendy's Apron: *Wednesday, November 10 from 10:00 a.m.—noon.* A 1940's style apron that is just fun to make and fun to wear! Complete with contrasting collar, pockets and band at the hem. Make one for a friend, too. Class fee \$10; pattern \$7.

- \* The class fee must be paid when registering for the class.
